I look forward to the rest of the year with exciting speakers and continuing to meet new friends.



The Florida House and Senate will be holding committee meetings during the coming months. The next

legislative session will start on March 4th and continue thru May 2, 2025. Even though our legislators

are not in full session the committee work is important and a time to let them know your thoughts on matters of interest to you. Don't hesitate to reach out to your state law makers; you can find out who

If contacting your representatives, don't forget to mentions these FREA issues as well:

1. Re-instating the Cost-of-Living Adjustment (COLA) for those in the Florida Retirement System. 2. Funding salaries for veteran teachers.

3. Allowing retired teachers who want to return the classroom sooner than the currently required

one year moratorium a pathway to do so.

4. Returning the default retirement option to the pension plan not the investment plan current new-hires are defaulted to.

As this year ends, consider how you can save money in 2025. How much do you send on ATM fees? The average free is \$4.77. That is up from last year. To avoid these fees, join a fee free bank like USAA or Charles Schwab. Withdraw at Publix instead of an ATM. (They will give you cash back when you purchase.) Use your bank ATM. If you are going on a trip, download an app that shows you where free ATMS are located. (information from Clark.com) Also stop writing checks! It's dangerous! Transit numbers at the bottom of the check let anyone into your account! The only person you can trust with a check is Jennifer when you pay your dues! Looking for a good book for 2025?
